**Subject: UPDATED OC Minyanim Guidelines**

Dear OC Community and Friends,

We have updated our Guidelines as public health requirements and guidance has recently changed. We take these precautions to daven together as safely as possible.

Minyanim at Ohr Chadash will adhere to the following standards:

- Attendees must be completely free of any COVID-19 symptoms, including: cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever (a temperature above 100.4°F), chills, muscle pain, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, new loss of taste or smell. - **Face coverings (i.e. masks) are required for all attendees five years or older per state public health order.** Masks are encouraged for those children 2+.
- Members and guests 12 years of age and older are **required** to verify their COVID-19 vaccination status for attending Shabbat and holiday services by providing proof of full vaccination status. Exceptions are possible in two cases:
  - Those who have tested positive for COVID-19 within the past three months.
  - Those who provide a negative PCR test result taken no earlier than 72 hours prior to services.
- Based on current CDC [guidance](#), if one has been infected with COVID-19 or has been exposed to an individual infected with COVID-19, Minyan Ohr Chadash leadership must be contacted as soon as possible to determine whether the person(s) should refrain from attending OC services or activities.
- Travel: In alignment with CDC [recommendations](#), fully vaccinated attendees are not required to quarantine or test upon arrival in Seattle. For those unvaccinated, the traveler(s) must quarantine for 7 days following arrival, take a COVID-19 test between days 3-5, and may attend services with a negative COVID-19 test on day 8. The traveler may also attend services after a 10-day quarantine without a test.
- **Children** are welcome to attend indoors with their parent(s).
  - Parents attending youth programs must wear a face covering regardless of vaccination status.

- Children attending the younger youth program are encouraged to wear a mask if age appropriate; children attending the older youth program must wear a mask.
- Those over the age of 65 or in a high-risk group (i.e., diabetic, high blood pressure, heart or lung disease, immunocompromised, etc.) should consult their physician before attending if unvaccinated.
- Abundant hand sanitizer will be available for use.

**Please note: These standards allow one to attend OC's minyanim, but they do not obligate one to attend. You acknowledge that you are attending OC's minyanim at your own risk. If you attend minyan but do not follow these standards, you may be asked to leave.**
